
Corpus Christi Procession

The Most Holy Trinity, Year B 26 May 2024



The Scripture Readings on this Trinity Sunday help us understand our relationship with God. We see God's uniqueness and power, our role as His children, and our mission to bring others into this relationship.

The first reading from Deuteronomy invites us to reflect on the unique ways God has interacted with Israel. Moses speaks to

the people, reminding them of the extraordinary acts God has done for them. They saw God speak from the fire and perform miracles to choose them above all other nations. This reading highlights God's unmatched power and His closeness to His people.

The second reading from Romans, tells us about the spirit of adoption we receive from God. Through the Holy Spirit, we are not just followers but children of God. This Spirit leads us and frees us from fear. We can call God "Father" with confidence and love.

In the Gospel Jesus gives them a great mission: to make disciples of all nations, baptize them, and teach them to follow His commands.

Jesus' command is a foundation for our mission as Christians. We are to share the good news with everyone, no matter where they are from. The task of baptizing and teaching is not just for the apostles but for all of us who follow Christ. Jesus also promises to be with us always, until the end of time. This assurance gives us the courage to carry out His commands.
