Reflection


The Gospel reading for this Sunday reports two miracles performed by Jesus in Galilee. The first is the raising to life of the daughter of Jairus. The second is the healing of a woman with a haemorrhage she had endured for twelve years. In each case, the miracle performed by Jesus is in response to a courageous act of faith.

The deep courage displayed by the bleeding woman and by Jairus is courage which is born through faith. Faith that in Jesus they could find life and that with Jesus, death had no power. Courage allowed them to take the risks, to stand firm against ridicule and judgement, and to reach towards Jesus. To seek Jesus out and to act.

We are also called to find courage through faith. To find the courage to seek Jesus out, and the courage to act. Each Sunday we are commissioned to leave Mass and to bring the life-giving hope and joy of the Gospel to our communities. To be the hands, feet, eyes, ears and voice of Jesus in our world. In his address to the thousands of gathered youth at the closing Mass of the 2023 World Youth Day in

Lisbon, Pope Francis urged, "Be not afraid ... it is Jesus himself who is looking at you in this moment, he is looking at you, He knows you, he knows the heart of each one of you, he knows the life of each one of you, he knows the joys, he knows the sadness, the successes and the failures...Be not afraid, be not afraid, take heart, be not afraid."
